RECOMMENDATION OF CANDIDATES FOR THE ZSL SCIENTIFIC MEDAL

Regulations

1. No serving member of Council is eligible to be nominated for the award.
2. The medal will be awarded to research scientists with no more than 15 years postdoctoral experience for distinguished work in Zoology. Time taken as a family or medically enforced career break of up to four years can be added.
3. Up to three medals may be awarded annually, subject to a high standard of merit being maintained.
4. Candidates recommended but not selected in any year may be considered by the Scientific Awards Committee in the following year, provided that the candidate is still within 15 years of completing their PhD (see 2 above).
5. Recommendations must be received by 10 January 2023.
