

# Pollinator Survey - Teacher Guide

## Use alongside the Pollinator ID sheet

### Survey Instructions

- Print off the Pollinator ID sheet from the link on the ZSL Biodiversity webpage.
- Travel to one of your 6 sample locations and input the date, time, location number (1-6), weather, air temperature (1 metre above the sample location) and wind conditions on the data collection sheet. You also need to record the flower coverage of the space up to 50cm<sup>2</sup> beyond your location marker. Identify the main types of flower varieties in this area.
- Stand calmly and quietly for 2 minutes to help the pollinators get used to your presence. This is a great time to carry out one of the Nature Connectedness activities, as long as it doesn't involve moving about.
- Using the ID sheet, look around and note both the species that you see and the number of each onto the data sheet. Run the activity for 5 minutes.
- If you are unsure about any of the pollinators sighted during this time, you can use the link at the bottom of this page.
- Add the data from your collection sheet onto the digital spreadsheet.
